Food legend shocked by AM award

A LIFETIME love of regional produce has made **Zannie Flanagan** an Adelaide food legend.

Ms Flanagan, of Port Willunga, became a Member of the Order of Australia (AM) last month for service to the SA food industry, including promoting regional produce through farmers' markets and the olive oil industry.

"I was really shocked - I didn't think I was old enough to get this sort of recognition," Ms Flanagan, 62, said.

"I heard a rumour that the nomination came via someone in government, which means

what we're doing is being noticed and taken seriously." She is currently working with other SA farmers' market operators to develop an accreditation system for the markets and their stallholders.

Ms Flanagan moved to SA from New Zealand in 1979, open-

ing up two restaurants including Prewett's in Kangarilla and the Salopian Inn in McLaren Vale.

"It was during this time that I realised the Fleurieu had the potential to develop a regional food culture if small food producers were supported and acknowledged.

"I thought a country restaurant should have food on the menu that reflected the surrounding countryside.

"I remember being very excited when someone came into the restaurant one day and asked if I would be interested in putting their goat's cheese on the menu."

In 2001, Ms Flanagan set up a committee to establish the Wil-

lunga Farmers' Market, which now has 70 stallholders, more than 2000 shoppers a week and a \$5 million annual turnover.

In 2006, she used the Willunga model to start the Adelaide Showground Farmers' Market and produced a DVD to assist other communities in setting up farmers' markets.

Ms Flanagan hoped her award would continue to help build the profile of SA farmers' markets and producers.

"We really want the public to support our own food producers, and consumers want to be able to have trust in the food chain," she said. "Only communities that can feed themselves are truly sustainable."
