



Woodside growing to meet increasing needs of tourists

WOODSIDE is one of the busier towns in the Adelaide Hills with a variety of boutique producers and cellar door outlets, open over seven days, to cater for the flow of tourists in summer and winter.

The town is described as a central location for touring to several other attractions and places within the Adelaide Hills because of the short driving distances involved.

Woodside itself is home to Woodside Cheese Wrights, which has been producing award-winning cheeses since 1994 from a range of cow and goat milk, including milk from small, local dairies.

A feature of the cheeses is that they are all crafted by hand.

Woodside Providore is a modern, licensed country café, offering a variety of wines, coffee, organic teas and seasonal foods like house-made Christmas puddings, dressings, mayos, pestos, jams and marmalades, either from the menu or takeaway.

The town is also home to Baylies of Strathalbyn, which produces crackers, pralines, shortbread, gourmet cakes, biscuits, confectionery, conserves and spiced fruits, available all year.

Consistent with business activity to cater for the popularity of Woodside as a tourist venue, there is renewed housing development to meet a growing demand for accommodation.
