




HALLOWEEN VAMPIRE JUICE serves 10 – makes 2 litres

 THIS RECIPE REQUIRES ADULT SUPERVISION

INGREDIENTS

- 2 punnets of strawberries
- ¼ seedless watermelon
- 2 tablespoons caster sugar, optional

EQUIPMENT

- sieve
- cutlery knife and large spoon
- chopping board
- blender
- large and small bowl

METHOD

1. To remove any sand or grit from strawberries place in a bowl of cold water and stir with your hand. Using your hand take out of sieve and place in a large sieve or colander positioned over the sink to drain off excess water.
2. With a cutlery knife cut off the green stem cut and into half. Place in blender goblet and replace lid securely. Blend till lump free. Pour into a bowl large enough to hold over 2 litres of liquid.
3. Using a large spoon scoop out pieces of water melon or ask an adult to help remove rind from watermelon with a knife and chop into pieces.
4. Place half of the watermelon into blender goblet and buzz to a smooth liquid. Add to strawberry juice. Repeat with remaining half of watermelon and mix all together in the large bowl.
5. Taste and if you think fellow vampires like a sweeter juice add the caster and stir till dissolved.

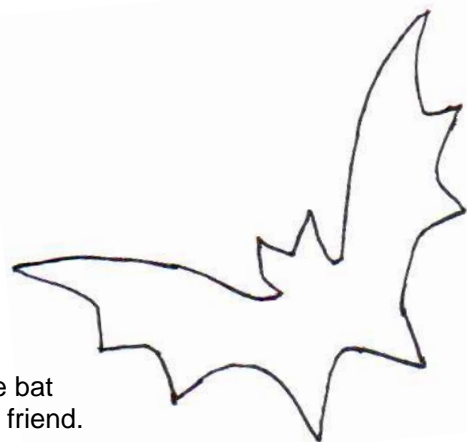
TO SERVE FROM JACK O LANTERN PUMPKIN

Pour into a jug or container that will fit inside your jack o lantern pumpkin. Ladle into glasses and serve with vampire bat straws.

TO MAKE VAMPIRE BAT STRAWS

- packet of red straws
- black A4 paper
- scissors
- sticky tape

1. Cut out this vampire bat and use as a template to draw onto some card from a cereal box.
2. Trace around your card template onto some black A4 paper.
3. Cut out black paper bats and with sticky tape fasten the bat at the top of blood red plastic drinking straws for each vampire friend.

HOW TO MAKE a jack o' lantern

GET AN adult to do THE CUTTING!!!!

Step 1. Whilst shopping at the Adelaide Showground Farmers Market choose a nice big round pumpkin (with some stem attached if possible).

Step 2. When you get it home draw a line around the pumpkin with a black washable felt tip pen where you want your lid to be.

Step 3. Put the pumpkin on its side. Ask an adult to carefully cut along the line with a sharp knife and remove the top of the pumpkin.

Step 4. To make sure it fits properly replace the lid of the pumpkin on top again and wipe away the black pen mark.

Step 5. Remove lid and scrape out the seeds and all the fibrous innards with a metal spoon.

Step 6. Make a hole inside large enough to hold your container of vampire juice. Save the pumpkin flesh to make pumpkin soup or pumpkin scones for hungry ghouls, ghosts, witches and fellow vampires.

Step 7. Using this picture as a guide. With the black pen draw two triangles for eyes and one for a nose, and draw a toothy grin. Ask an adult to cut out a face for you. Keep the cut outs simple to make it easier.

Step 8. Wipe away any remaining black pen lines.

Step 9. Your Jack o' Lantern is now ready to serve your vampire juice from.....
or you can put a tea – light candle in it for Halloween night.
