

clucky chook cRAFT

MAKE a WHACKY CHICK THAT REALLY CLUCKS

MaTERials

- 1 white or yellow plastic cup
- 1 bamboo skewer
- 2cm square of red felt or 4cm long red ribbon
- 60cm long piece of string
- 4cm x 4cm square of kitchen sponge
- coloured feathers
- googly eyes
- PVA white glue or a glue gun
- orange paper triangle cut from orange paper (or white paper coloured with an orange felt tip pen)



iNSTRuCTIONS

1. In the centre of the bottom of the cup make a small hole with the sharp end of the bamboo skewer.
2. Fold the square of red felt or ribbon in half and tie one end of the string around the middle tightly.
3. From the outside poke the loose end of the string through the hole in the bottom of the cup. Pull the string all the way down until the red material meets the cup and resembles a chicken's red comb.
4. Tie the loose end of the string around the middle of the piece of sponge.
5. Glue some feathers on the sides of the cup for wings.
6. Stick googly eyes on the cup. Glue the orange paper triangle between the eyes for a beak to make the chicken's face, and let dry for about 5 minutes.
7. Dip the sponge in water and wet your hand. Using your thumb and forefinger, fold the sponge around the string (where it meets the opening of the cup) and pinch together tightly.
8. Place the cup over one hand like a puppet. With your wet hand grasp the string near the top and with quick, jerky motions, yank the sponge down the string (a little bit at a time a time) to make the chick cluck!
